



Sikaflex® Challenge

Ultimate Build -a- Boat Race

Sika Corporation is proud to present the SikaFlex® Challenge at the Door County Classic & Wooden Boat Festival, Sturgeon Bay, WI

The Challenge:

To design, build and race a small boat using limited materials and fast-curing Sikaflex 291 adhesive/sealant.

Construction Saturday 10am—2pm followed by decoration until Sunday at 9 am.

A maximum number of 12 teams will compete for the coveted Sikaflex Challenge Cup. Each team, consisting of two members, will be allotted up to four hours to complete their boat using only the following supplied materials:

- 3 — Sheets of 1/4" plywood
- 2 — 2' x 2' x 8' boards
- 4 — 1' x 2' x 10' boards
- 1 — Caulk gun
- Sikaflex 291 adhesive/sealant
- Zip ties

In addition, each team is allowed the use of the following (must be supplied by the contestants):

- Sawhorses
- Tape Measure
- Pliers
- Sabre Saw
- Cordless Drill
- Other hand-tools as approved by judges

The following restrictions apply:

- No nails are allowed
- All boats must be bonded using Sikaflex 291
- Zip ties or cable ties may be used to hold the boat together while Sikaflex 291 is curing but they must be removed prior to the sea trials.
- Absolutely no power tools other than those specified are allowed.

The Rules:

- Two people per team. Both must be on hand for the building portion and sea trials.
- At least one team member must be 18 years of age. Ages 12-17 must have the written permission of their parent or guardian.
- Boats and paddles must be made from provided materials.
- No patterns or templates allowed.
- No additional propulsion allowed.
- Shoes required for the sea trials.
- No alcoholic beverages allowed at any time.
- Type III flotation devices must be worn during sea trials.
- Unsafe practices will be stopped.

Refusal to comply with the rules will result in immediate disqualification. The decision of the judges in selection of the competing teams is final. Vessels can and should be painted. Themed decorations are encouraged with the people's choice voting to determine the best decorated vote which is recognized on the Palmer Johnson Trophy.
