



Greetings!

Planning a group tour to Wisconsin's Door Peninsula in the near future? We encourage you to include the Door County Maritime Museum on Sturgeon Bay's waterfront in your plans. Better understanding of the Peninsula's rich maritime heritage will enhance your visit so please consider booking a tour. It's shaping up to be another big year here at the Maritime Museum in 2020.

The exhibit "Shipwrecks of Door County" returns for a second year. Starting with the history of diving, to the sailing schooner through a storm and eventually becoming sunk in the bay of Green Bay. Learn why the peninsula's shipwrecks are so well preserved in the Lake Michigan waters. Explore the map and learn of many of the shipwrecks on the shores of the Door Peninsula finishing with the Chapel. Which brings you to the human side of what has been found on the shipwrecks.

In addition, the 149-foot Tug *John Purves* was added to the Museum's group tour package in 2009. The docent-led tour is enormously popular as groups marvel at the 32,000-plus hours of work contributed to the 100-year-old tug's restoration.

Docents will also guide your group through galleries highlighting the area's significant shipbuilding heritage, its unmatched collection of lighthouses and maritime innovation such as the first shipping container.

This comprehensive 2 1/2-hour tour including both the museum and tug costs \$12 per adult. **Please note, we continue to offer the shorter museum-only tour at \$8.00 per person.** We ask that you allow at least 75 minutes for the museum-only tour. Complimentary admissions for both the tour escort and driver are again provided. This pricing is guaranteed through reservations made prior to September 30, 2020

The museum also offers docent-led tours at its Gills Rock facility. Located at the tip of the Door Peninsula, the museum dedicates considerable space to the area's commercial fishing history. The restored fishing tug *Hope* is housed inside the building. Tour fee is \$5.00 per adult.

Travel back in time and explore Cana Island Lighthouse, one of Wisconsin's most popular lighthouses, that has stood watch over the Lake Michigan Shores for 150 years, Weather permitting cross the causeway on a tractor drawn hay wagon. The island includes a 89 foot tower, the original keepers house, the oil house, barn and privy. If you are able you may climb to the top of the tower to see breathtaking view of Lake Michigan and the Door Peninsula. Admission fee for the island is \$12.00 per adult.

We are eager to serve your group and hope you will include the Door County Maritime Museum on your visit to Door County. Our museums are handicap accessible with ample free parking. As one would expect, the tug does include narrow steps. However, alternate routes have been established to allow those unable to navigate some areas to experience a rewarding tug tour experience. If you plan to visit Cana Island, we ask that you contact us in advance for details.

### Cana Island Lighthouse Station

#### Scheduling Process:

- Please book at least two weeks prior to arrival date
- Tours can be booked inside the 14 day window but only if the museum has availability on the day requested
- All tour reservations require a \$50 deposit (this will be credited when tour is admitted)
- Remaining balance due on day of tour (based on number of people in the tour)
- Tours outside of regular business hours (and within 1 hour of scheduled open or close) are subject to a service charge of \$25
- Requests to tour more than 1 hour from museum opening and closing times are subject to approval of DCMM Executive Director.
- **PLEASE NOTE: We may have a price increase after September 30, 2020. Please check with us if you plan on coming after September 30, 2020 for pricing.**

#### Cancellation & Refund Policy:

- If museum receives notice at least 3 business days before the tour date, 100% refund provided
- If museum receives notice less than 3 days before event date, the deposit is non-refundable
- If group arrives more than 20 minutes later than scheduled, docent may not be available and tour may be cancelled, without refund
